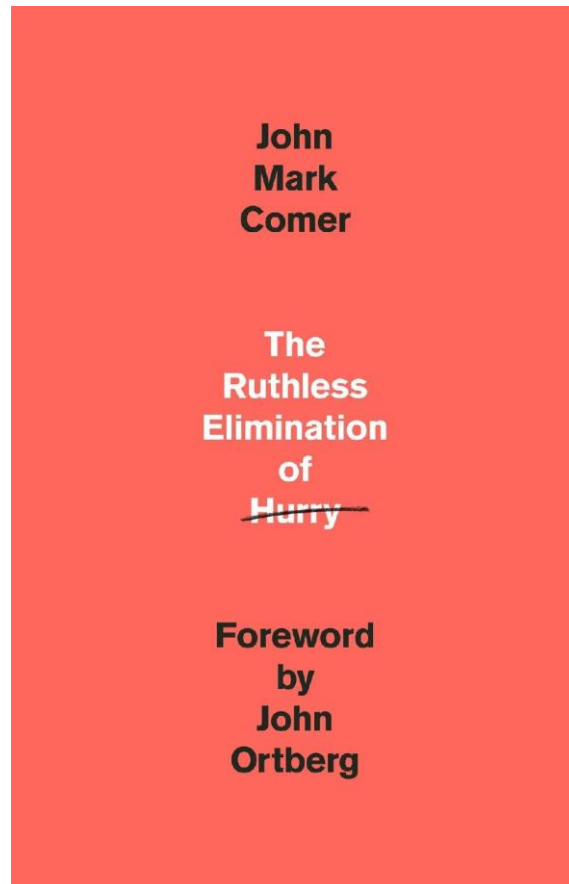

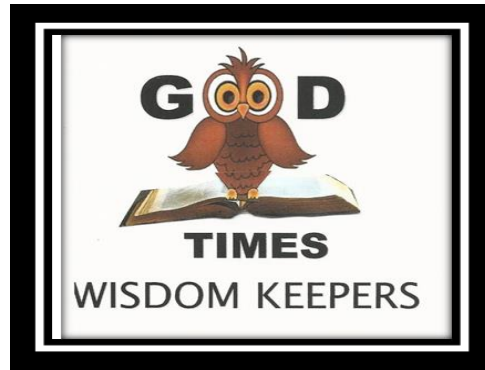
We will have boxes available in the Narthex and Welcome Center for Candy or you can make a donation and we will buy the candy for you!

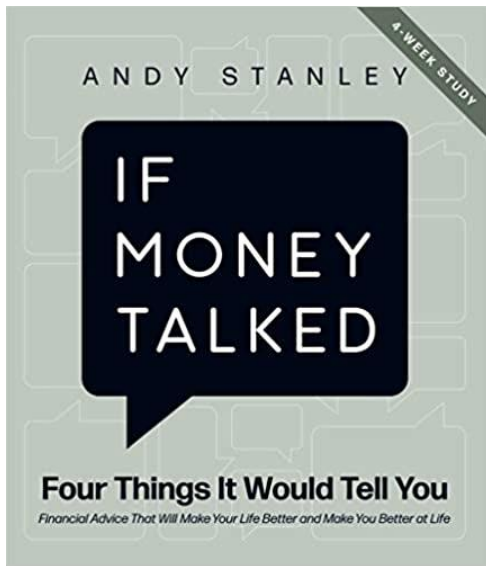
