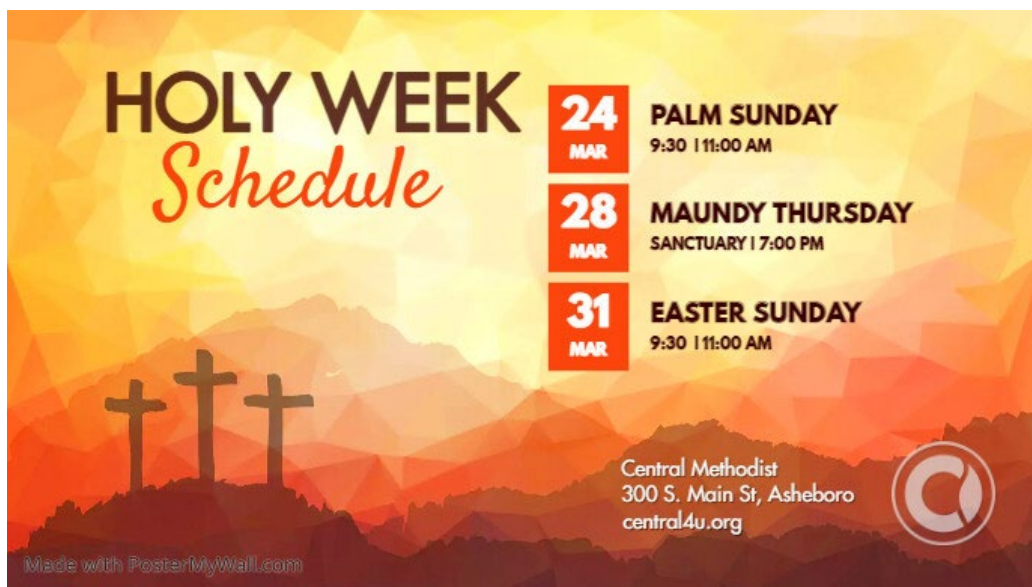
Series: Givin' It Up For Lent

Thursday, March 14 (Trip to Virginia)

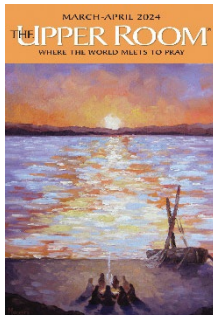
